2021 & 2022 CESERT PYRAMID GRANTS

With your help, the ASEF funded 10 surgical education research grants for ASE members in 2021. This research will impact how we educate the next generation of surgeons and surgical educators. Funded projects include topics in wellness curricula, robotic surgery, feedback, skills assessment, and virtual learning during COVID-19. Awards included six \$500 Gold Awards, two \$2,500 Diamond Awards, one \$10,000 Platinum Award, and one \$25,000 Giant Robot Award. Dr. Carter Lebares MD FACS from the University of California San Francisco Department of Surgery, who received the Platinum Award explains, "We are conducting a mixed-methods study of trainees at 16 US General Surgery residency programs to address the gap in our collective understanding of what promotes and prevents wellbeing in surgical trainees and how to optimize the use of precious resources to achieve the highest impact on trainee wellbeing. The Association for Surgical Education Foundation Platinum Grant has allowed us to incentivize resident participation and benefit from expert biostatisticians, both of which are essential to making this work impactful and rigorous."

We are thrilled to announce that Intuitive will fund two \$25,000 robotic grants for 2022, and we plan to offer 13 additional grants this year. Our 2022 grant application cycle opened November 11, 2021 and the submission deadline is February 15, 2022.



Grant proposals that focus on the theme of virtual (either synchronous or asynchronous) instruction or assessment topics will receive special priority. We encourage all of you with innovative research ideas to apply!
