Surgical Education and Leadership Fellowship (SELF)

OBJECTIVES

The ASE Surgical Education and Leadership Fellowship (SELF) is a **one-year fellowship** designed for all ASE members who wish to improve their teaching, education design, and leadership skills in surgical education. The Fellowship is designed as an ongoing self and mentored program throughout the course of one year. Participants will be assigned an experienced advisor who will meet with each fellow three times during the year to coach and advise on a teaching area that each fellow individually identifies that they want to improve. Advisors are carefully assigned to ensure the “best fit” for the fellow’s interest.

INTENDED PARTICIPANTS

All members of the ASE, including Residents/Fellows/Physicians and Education Scientists who wish to develop or hone their skills to become more effective teachers and education leaders.

APPLICATION PROCESS & COST

Applicants must complete the online SELF Application Form (<https://www.surgicaleducation.com/self-application-form/>) and submit it with required attachments by January 13, 2023. Course tuition is \$2,500.00. Travel and Lodging not included.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Attend four sessions:
1. Attendance of all SELF sessions:

Session #1 and #2:

Held parallel to Surgical Education Week (SEW) in San Diego, CA: Session 1 will be a full day interactive course providing fellows with the foundations of set and teaching. Session 2 will be a half day interactive course providing fellows with the foundations of teaching and closure.

Session 1: Wednesday, April 12, 2023

8:00am-5:00 pm Pacific Time

Session 2: Thursday, April 13, 2023

10:30am-2:30pm Pacific Time

Session #3:

Full day interactive course providing fellows with an introduction to leadership skills. This session will culminate with each fellow identifying an area of teaching that they want to improve on via coaching/advising.

Session #4:

Held During Surgical Education Week (following year): All fellows present reflections on their development as a teacher in a forum setting.
